Intestacy Request and Indemnity

This form is to be used where the deceased Securityholder dies without leaving a valid Will. It replaces our requirement for Probate when the paid up value of the securityholding is less than NZ\$15,000.00

Please complete the form on the reverse based on the following instructions:

Step 1: Details of the deceased

Please provide the following details (this information can be found on the latest Securities Transaction Statement or Remittance Advice):

- The Common Shareholder Number (CSN) or Holder Number.
- The full name of the registered Securityholder.
- The address details as they appear on the register.

Step 2: Details of the applicant (next of kin)

Provide the full name and relationship to the deceased of the next of kin.

Step 3: Signing instructions and statutory declaration

The next of kin must sign in the space provided in front of a person qualified to take a statutory declaration, for example, a Solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand, A Justice of the Peace or a Solicitor/Notary Public in the country of death.

The person taking the statutory declaration should also complete and sign the relevant section of the form and stamp the form in the box provided.

Step 4: Returning your form

The original *'Intestacy Request and Indemnity'* form(s) must be returned to Computershare along with a certified copy of the death certificate, certified copy of the marriage certificate or birth certificate confirming the relationship with the deceased, written consent from all other parties that could be entitled to a distribution from the Estate, and completed *'Estate Transfer'* form(s). We are unable to accept a copy, fax or email of this form; please return the original form to the address above.

Checklist

- Completed *'Intestacy Request and Indemnity'* form signed with statutory declaration
- Certified copy of the death certificate
- Certified copy of the marriage certificate or birth certificate confirming relationship with the deceased
- Original or certified copy of written consent from other interested parties (if applicable)
- Completed *'Estate Transfer'* forms (one for each security held)
